## i) Arrangement dated 2007/01

B-Type Liquid Funds, previously classified in mutual funds under the items of "non-bank financial institutions", have been followed a new institutional unit of monetary sector in the sectoral accounts of central bank and banks beginning from the data of December 2005 with the arrangements made on January 2007 (In order to comply with international standards, definition of monetary sector is expanded to cover Investment and Development Banks, Participation Banks and B-Type Liquid Funds (Money Market Funds) in addition to the Central Bank and Deposit Bank).

## ii) Regulation dated 2015/01

Through the regulation introduced in January 2015, for harmonization purposes with international standards, the "Private Pension Funds" item, which used to be monitored under Investment Funds in the Banking System Balance Sheets and Sectoral Balance Sheets and Monetary Survey tables, was reclassified under Insurance Companies and Pension Funds.
