

i) Arrangement dated 2002/12

The subsectors of "Non-Bank Financial Institutions" are classified as "Insurance Corporations and Pension Funds", "Financial Intermediaries" and "Financial Auxiliaries" beginning from the data of December 2002. Additionally Financial Intermediaries are classified as "Financial Leasing Companies", "Factoring Companies", "Financing Companies", "Mutual Funds" and "Other Financial Intermediaries". Financial auxiliaries are classified as "Saving Deposit Insurance Fund (SDIF) and "Other Financial Auxiliaries. These breakdowns are reflected to banks' related tables.

ii) Arrangement dated 2007/01

The accounts of Capital Market Board and Banking Regulation and Supervision Agency taken place in Central Bank records which were previously classified in "Central Government" are included in "Non Bank Financial Institutions" beginning from the data of December 2005 with the arrangements made on January 2007. These arrangements are reflected to Central Bank's related tables.
